Install the software package on Linux you can install the JDK and NetBeans IDE software in the guide of your choice. You must be a root user to use this installer unless you choose to install this package to a system-specific location. NOTE: This installer does not replace the system version of the Java platform provided by the operating system. On the installation type page, select the appropriate option below: To perform a standard installation of the software package, click Install. To specify a different installation location, click Change Installation Location. (Optional, required If you clicked Change installation location in step 4) on the Select Destination page, specify the disk for the software package installation, and click Continue. (Optional, required If you clicked Change installation location in step 4) on the Installation type page, click Install. Enter your system name and password and click Install Software to begin the installation. The Install page shows the progress of the installation. When the installation is complete, click Close on the Summary page. Uninstalling the software from Windows Each product in the package must be removed separately. To uninstall an IDE: Turn off the IDE. In Control Panel, select Uninstall a program. Select NetBeans IDE 8.0.2 and click Remove. To uninstall JDK and JavaFX 2.2: From Control Panel, select Uninstall Program. Select Java(TM) SE Development Kit 7 Update 80 from the list and click Remove. NOTE: If you uninstall the JDK, but want to continue using NetBeans IDE 8.0.2, you must set the -jdkhome option of the IDE to indicate another installation of the JDK as described below. To uninstall the Java Runtime Environment: In Control Panel, select Uninstall a program. Select Java 7 Update 80 from the list and click Remove. To change the value of -jdkhome: Navigate to the folder etc. of the NetBeans IDE installation directory. The default location is C:\Program Files\NetBeans 8.0.2\etc. Open the netbeans.conf file in a text editor and edit the netbeans_jdkhome option. NOTE: Java TM SE Development Kit (JDK) 5.0 and JDK 6 are not supported on any platform for this release. You must have JDK Update 7 10 (or newer) on the system to install and run NetBeans IDE 8.0.2. Uninstalling the software from Linux each product in the package must be removed separately. To uninstall an IDE: Navigate to the NetBeans IDE installation directory. Type `./uninstall.sh` to turn on Device Remover. To uninstall JDK and JavaFX 2.2: Remove the JDK installation directory. Uninstalling the software from OS X must be separately removed from each product in the package. To uninstall the IDE: Turn off the software. Drag the program or files folders to the Trash. Note that the default location for the IDE and application server is /Applications/NetBeans/.
